7 out of 10 young people who grow up in the church will abandon their faith by age 23.

ORIGINAL PROJECT OBJECTIVES

1. Create a re-designed, secure environment for our elementary school discipleship ministry for 1st through 5th grades.
2. Build four additional Community Rooms, allowing for expansion of adult community ministry.
3. Connect our Sanctuary and Leonard Hall buildings, creating continuity and making our campus more secure.
4. Add approximately 10,000 finished square feet to our footprint, giving us more space in which to do ministry.
5. Renovate restroom facilities to be accessible and ADA compliant.
6. Give a needed facelift to an aging building.
7. Increase available parking spaces by paving the current dirt lots
